

Competency Based Skills for 6th Grade

Math Competencies	
Ratios	Students understand ratio concepts and use ratio reasoning to solve problems.
Number Systems	Students apply and extend previous understandings of multiplication and division to divide fractions by fractions. Students multiply and divide multi-digit numbers and find common factors and multiples. Students apply and extend previous understandings of numbers to the system of rational numbers.
Expression, Equations, & Inequalities	Students apply and extend previous understandings of arithmetic to algebraic expressions. Students reason about and solve one-variable equations and inequalities. Students represent and analyze quantitative relationships between dependent and independent variables.
Geometry	Students solve real-world and mathematical problems involving area, surface area, and volume.
Statistics & Probability	Students will develop understanding of statistical variability. Students will summarize and describe distributions.

Language Competencies	
Foundations of Writing	With guidance, students can edit and revise my text for clarity and coherence (e.g., conventions, grammar, focus, pacing, use of sensory details and precise language with intent).
Narrative Writing	Students will produce clear, coherent, and effective narrative writing for a range of types, purposes, and audiences (e.g., blogs, podcasts, and historical fiction/accounts).
Informational Writing	Students will produce clear, coherent, and effective informative writing for a range of types, purposes, and audiences.
Opinion/Argument Writing	Students will produce clear, coherent, and effective opinion/argument writing for a range of text types, purposes, and audiences.
Speaking-Listening and Language	Students will initiate and participate effectively in speaking-listening for a variety of purposes and audiences (e.g., informal discussions, formal presentations), responding respectfully to diverse perspectives and expressing ideas clearly and purposefully.

Reading Competencies

Foundational Reading Skills	Students will read to make meaning while flexibly using a variety of strategies, applying and extending literacy skill with increasing independence.
Literature	Students will comprehend and draw conclusions about the author's intent when reading a variety of increasingly complex print and non-print literary texts
Informational Text	Students will comprehend and draw conclusions about the author's intent in a variety of increasingly complex print and non-print informational texts, citing textual evidence to support their analyses.
