Dear Kindergarten Families,

I know it is hard to believe that in a few short months your child will be entering kindergarten at Lafayette. I am excited about your child's journey through Lafayette and hope you are too! Please call our school at 603-823-7741 to receive the forms necessary to register your child. If you have received forms from the office, please send them back to school at your earliest convenience to complete your child's registration.

In your packet, you will find a Kindergarten Readiness Activity Handbook. This handbook has many practice pages you can do with your child this summer to promote kindergarten readiness skills. This is not required, just some practice for those of you interested in promoting some academic skills before school starts in August. You will also find a checklist of academic and independent skills that will give you an idea of what a kindergartner will be expected to do at the beginning of school in August. These are skills to work on with your child over the summer. Remember, this is not meant to be a burden on you, but a way to support your child's growth. Your child does not need to check every item off the list. A great goal is for your child to have a strong handle on the majority of skills. The most important thing to do this summer is to have fun with your child!

At this event, kindergartners will get a chance to explore their classroom. They will be able to find their seat, cubby and locker, as well as, get a chance to meet me.
