





May 3rd, 2024 6:00pm At Lafayette School









#### NH Fuel, Electric and Rental Assistance

The federal government runs programs to help those in need with their fuel and electricity bills. If you qualify for either one, you qualify for both. New Hampshire has a program called the Tri-County Community Action Program.

They are located at Tri-County Community Action Program, 41 School Street, Ashland, NH 03217.

You can contact them by mail, email, or phone to see if you can receive assistance. I would suggest calling them to see if you qualify at 603-968-3560. If you do, they will send you documents to fill out and submit. The assistance is substantial and is paid directly to the utility company. You can also email the following people with questions:

The application process is still open. This program applies to renters only. This is a grant program and the funds are paid directly to the utility supplier.

Tri County Cap also offers rental assistance.

The NH Emergency Rental Assistance Program will cover up to 15 months of:

- Past-due and future rent payments, including late fees and legal fees (back to April 1, 2020)
- Past-due and future utilities and home heating costs (back to March 13, 2020)
- Other housing-related costs such as internet and relocation expenses including rental application fees, utility hook-up fees, and security deposits
